- Enhance fundraising & cultivation policy for the organization
- · Identify strategic relationships and recognize 'transition' readiness to Major Gifts
- Serve as direct supervisor of Engagement Coordinator
- Strategically equip the CEO with resources and systems for effective donor portfolio management to maximize Major Gift opportunities
