Attainable Homeownership Tax Credit

How it works:

- Who** AHTC is available to all Indiana tax-payers - individuals, couples, businesses, and corporations - in Indiana who make a donation to Habitat for Humanity of Indiana.
- What** These tax credits may be used to offset individual income or business taxes in the tax year the donation is made. Eligible donations include cash, stock, approved land gifts, and approved new construction materials.
- How** The tax credit is equal to 50% of the donation made to Habitat. For example, a gift of \$1000 qualifies you for a \$500 tax credit. There is a cap of \$10,000 in tax credits allowed per tax year (with a \$20,000 donation), but unused credits may be carried over for up to 5 years. If you itemize deductions on your federal return, additional tax savings may be possible!
- Where** Donations must be made to Habitat for Humanity of Indiana in order to process your credits. All donations will be distributed to our local affiliate, as long as you indicate "Habitat for Humanity of Monroe County" on your Donor Contribution Form.

When you give to Habitat for Humanity of Monroe County, you are making an impact on families that will last generations.



Homeowners have a greater ability to build generational wealth than renters, and children of homeowners are more likely to become homeowners themselves.



Children growing up in stable, high-quality housing experience less depression, anxiety, and have better overall mental and physical health than those who live in poor-quality housing.



Children of low-income homeowners are 11% more likely to graduate from high school and are 4.5% more likely to complete post-secondary education than children of low-income renters.



Habitat homeowners and their children develop relationships with their future neighbors through education classes and shared experiences before even breaking ground on their home.
