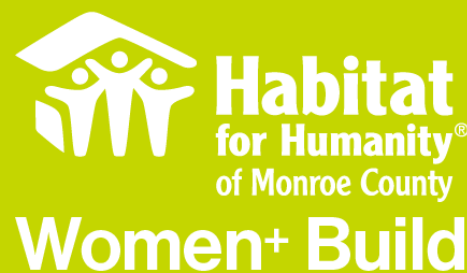


Attainable Homeownership Tax Credit



New this year - you can support Habitat for Humanity of Monroe County's Women+ Build while earning a state tax credit!

How does AHTC work?

Tax credits may be used to offset individual state income taxes or business taxes. When you donate to Habitat, you can receive a tax credit worth 50% of your donation, up to \$10,000 in tax credits. This means that a donation of \$1,000 could result in a \$500 tax credit for you or your small business.

Gifts through the tax credit program must be a minimum of \$500, and must be made to Habitat for Humanity of Indiana with a [Donor Contribution Form](#). Habitat of Indiana will then disburse donations to our affiliate in Monroe County.

Once the donation is received, it will be added to our online [Women+ Build fundraising page](#) and attributed to the builder(s) you are supporting. To ensure we apply your donation to the correct builder(s), please add their name to the memo of your check or send [this completed donation form](#) to habitat@monroecountyhabitat.org or 213 East Kirkwood Avenue, Bloomington IN 47408.
